- For the period October 1998 to August 2008, Mr. Van Essche has not provided any form of references and referees on his PHP to attest to his career spanning 10 years;
- In fact, the only name provided is that of Mr. Fergal Mullen (from CTP), who Mr. Van Essche cites as being his Supervisor at CTP – some 10 years ago;
- We find it highly irregular that Mr. Van Essche does not cite the CEO of LeftBrain, Mr. Richard King, as a referee. We were unable to reach Mr. King.
