I came to know her while she was the Head of Finance in Kosovo Trust Agency (KTA) which was and is the body in charge of governing the publicly and socially owned enterprises in Kosovo - such as Telecommunications, Energy, Railways, Airport, etc. she was a permanent thorn in the flesh on those in KTA and UNMIK who tried to make shortcuts to arrange for their own benefit or for their friends, etc Especially in the procurement issues she was constantly trying to bring things right - and that is also where I as the auditor General - together with the head if the internal audit Service in KTA - had contacts. - Finally she evidently became too difficult for them and her contract

was not renewed.
