## REMARK BY AMBASSADOR U. JOY OGWU, PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF NIGERIA TO UN ON PRESENTATION OF A \$500.000 CHEQUE TO AMB. KYAW TINT SWE, PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF MYANMAR TO UN, AS NIGERIAN GOVERNMENT'S CYCLONE NARGIS RELIEF CONTRIBUTION
