Understanding, and refrain from any steps that could undermine confidence or prejudice the outcome of negotiations;

- 4. Calls on all States and international organizations to contribute to an atmosphere conducive to negotiations and to support the Palestinian government that is committed to the Quartet principles and the Arab Peace Initiative and respects the commitments of the Palestinian Liberation Organization, to assist in the development of the Palestinian economy, to maximize the resources available to the Palestinian Authority, and to contribute to the Palestinian institution-building program in preparation for statehood;
- 5. Urges an intensification of diplomatic efforts to foster in parallel with progress in the bilateral process mutual recognition and peaceful coexistence between all states in the region in the context of achieving a comprehensive, just, and lasting peace in the Middle East;
- 6. Welcomes the Quartet's consideration, in consultation with the parties, of an international meeting in Moscow in 2009; and,

concluding a peace treaty resolving all outstanding france, including all core

7. Decides to remain seized of the matter.
