**Lack of Security Risk Analyses
Threatens Staff Security and Health**

The Staff Council,

Recalling the Staff Council Resolution 43/03 of 12 March 2009 expressing staff concerns over safety and health issues surrounding the Capital Master Plan (CMP);

Deeply concerned that Security Risk Analyses (SRA) have not been completed as mandated under the United Nations Security Risk Management system, on any of the buildings that will be used as swing space during the CMP, including the Headquarters Complex itself;

Noting that the United Nations Security Risk Management system has yet to be implemented in the United States of America, including the Headquarters building and all its annexes;

Noting the multiple failures of the Chief of the Security and Safety Services at Headquarters to follow mandated procedures to ensure the safety and security of all United Nations staff and delegation members;

The Staff Council decides to,

- (a) *Request* the Secretary-General to suspend all scheduled staff transfers to the new office spaces until such time as the mandated SRA have been properly executed wherever staff are to be located in accordance with prescribed security protocols; and
- (b) *Request* the President of the Staff Union to bring this resolution to the attention of the Secretary-General, the President of the General Assembly, the members of the Fifth Committee, the members of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, and all other interested parties.
