Dear Alicia,

I mentioned the other day, en passant, got a message from a person I came to know in Kosovo and who has applied for the D2 in PS in DM. Her name is Danielle Coolen and she is a Belgian citizen as far as I know. See her e-mail to me as well as her CV below. I have deleted some personal comments.

I came to know her while she was the Head of Finance in Kosovo Trust Agency (KTA) which was and is the body in charge of governing the publicly and socially owned enterprises in Kosovo - such as Telecommunications, Energy, Railways, Airport, etc. she was a permanent thorn in the flesh on those in KTA and UNMIK who tried to make shortcuts to arrange for their own benefit or for their friends, etc. Especially in the procurement issues she was constantly trying to bring things right - and that is also where I as the Auditor General - together with the head of the internal audit Service in KTA - had contacts. - Finally she evidently became too difficult for them and her contract

was not renewed.

I have not worked directly with her, so therefore I am not in a position to directly recommend her, but I would definitely advise you to see to it that she be interviewed and seriously considered. As it is a D2 I guess you would probably be yourself on an interview panel. In my experience, she would be the capacity that DM would need in the present state of affairs.
